VISION SUNDAY: Part 1 **Sunday 22nd October 2006** **Tom Shaw**

The morning was spent re-visiting our God-inspired church vision statement. The 6 key elements of the phrase were examined and the question asked: 'How are we doing as a community in each of these areas?'

Please use the following 3 questions for discussion in groups of 2 or 3:

- 1. Cell was shown to be a vital tool to maintain intimacy and community amidst a growing church. In what ways can you as a cell grow closer together? What practical steps can be taken to ensure the deepening of our church community as well as broadening through numerical growth?**
- 2. To what degree is 'Jesus the centre' of your cell? Is prayer a prominent aspect of your times together?**
- 3. Is cell-based mission something that excites you as a cell or something you find challenging? Make some decisions as a group for the year ahead as to how you can step out more in this.**

Please consider these final 3 questions as a whole cell group and record your answers for¹ use as feedback to us as elders as we aim to 'take the pulse of the church' at this time of the year:

- 1. What aspect(s) of church life in your opinion has seen the most positive change in the past 12 months?**
- 2. What aspect/project of church life does the cell feel God is most highlighting for the year ahead?**
- 3. As a cell, how can you play your part in the church fulfilling it's vision statement?**
