Title: Jesus Wins

1. Can you find the seven uses of victory language in the New Testament? (One in Colossians 2:13-15, one in Revelation 5:5, three in 1 Corinthians 15:54-57, one in 2 Corinthians 2:14, one in Romans 8:35-37)
2. What sort of victory is described in each passage?
 - a. Col 2 - deleting accusations (legal victory) and disarming rulers/authorities
 - b. Rev 5 - delivering us (compare with 5:9)
 - c. 1 Cor 15 - defeating death, swallowing it up completely, releasing us
 - d. 2 Cor 2 and Rom 8 - distributing that victory to us, and allowing us to participate
3. At the end of his talk, Andrew focused on the way we become "super-conquerors" or "over-winners" through Christ Jesus. How and why does this work?
4. What practical applications does this have for us as a community, as we go through trials and difficulties of many kinds (trouble, danger, hardship, even death), as Paul says?
5. How would you communicate the gospel to an unbelieving friend, using the "Jesus Wins" approach? Are there people you know for whom this would be a helpful way of explaining the good news? What questions would it raise?
